## MARY STOTLER AWARD

Presented by CIT and RID

Mary Stotler was a cherished interpreter in Seattle, Washington, greatly respected by the Deaf Community and an interpreter educator who influenced our field greatly. She was a founding member and a former Board member of the Conference of Interpreter Trainers and active in the field of interpreting and interpreter education throughout the Pacific Northwest.

The Mary Stotler Award, first given in 1985, is a national award that is jointly awarded by the Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf, Inc. (RID), and the Conference of Interpreter Trainers (CIT). The purpose of this award is to recognize significant contributions to the field of interpretation and interpreter education. A committee of 2 members each from CIT and RID will review nominations and select the winner(s).

### RECIPIENT WILL BE PRESENTED WITH:

- plaque awarded at CIT Conference
- announcement and recognition during RID Conference
- announcement in CIT NEWS and RID *VIEWS*
- cash award of \$1,000
- full Conference registration for the next CIT and RID Conferences
- name added to plaque in RID Office

### CRITERIA:

Failure to follow the rules below will render the nomination invalid.

The nominee must:

- be a current member of both CIT and RID
- be an interpreter practitioner
- be an interpreter educator
- have made significant contributions to the advancement of interpreting and interpreter education

Each nomination must include:

- application form
- current curriculum vita
- letter of nomination signed by 10 current CIT and/or RID members (3 CIT; 3 RID; 4 either)
- letter summarizing why this person should be honored (maximum of 3 pages) detailing his/her current work, history in the profession, degrees, topics addressed, activities performed and other accomplishments and contributions to the fields of interpreting and interpreter education

Nominators must submit 6 copies of the application and documentation for each Committee member plus the liaisons from the CIT and RID Boards. All material will be sent to the RID National Office where the staff representative will send copies to the Committee members and liaisons.

### CYCLE:

Nomination materials must be postmarked by July 1st of the award year.
